Lesson #6

God's Attributes

An "attribute" is a quality or characteristic that is true of someone. Studying the attributes of God allows us to have a better understanding of God's Person. An attribute of God is whatever God has in any way revealed as being true of Himself. Even though some concepts exceed the limits of our comprehension, our ideas concerning God need to be as true as possible.

God's Attributes Defined

Immutability

God never changes in His nature or purpose. He changes not! (Hebrews 13:8).

Omniscience
