1407 - Moses dies; Joshua conquers Canaan

1069 - Samuel begins to minister

1011 - Saul and Jonathan slain; David becomes king of Judah

1004 - David becomes king over all Israel

971 - Solomon ascends the throne

858 - Elijah begins to prophesy

776 - Olympic Games begin in Greece
