Four Important Areas of Prayer- the "ACTS" Model		
Adoration	Reflect on God Himself. Praise Him for His attributes, His majesty, His gift of Christ.	
Confession	Admit to God you have sinned. Be honest and humble. Remember, He knows you and loves you.	
Thanksgiving	Tell God how grateful you are for everything He has given you, even the unpleasant things. Your thankfulness will help you see His purposes.	
S upplication	Make specific requests. Pray for other first, then for yourself.	
Notice the first lette	ers of these four words form the word "ACTS." Use them as a mental guide to maintain balance as you pray.

Jesus' Pattern for Prayer: Matthew 6:9-13		
Pray to God	Our Father Who art in heaven	
Praise and exalt Him saying	Hallowed by thy name	
Submit to Him praying	Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done	
Look to Him seeking	Our daily bread (food & provision)	
Confess to Him pleading	Forgive us our debts (sins)	
Depend on Him asking	Lead us not into temptation	
Trust in Him requesting	Deliver us from evil
