GANDALF (cont'd) (remembering) The grey rain-curtain of this world rolls back, and all turns to silver glass... (to himself) and then you see it...

ANGLE ON: GANDALF breaks off, lost in reverie...

PIPPIN What, Gandalf? See what?

GANDALF White shores ... And beyond... a far green country under a swift sunrise.

- Streets of Gold!
- Saints that have gone on before!
- The very throne of God!
- And our Savior, the Lamb of God!

PIPPIN stares up at the OLD WIZARD'S FACE, softened, quiet and full of peace...

PIPPIN (quiet) Well, that isn't so bad.
