## The Associate

Second-class, second-hand, second level, below, under, assistant, helper, supporter, aide, and more- all these words carry the popular meaning of "not as important, substandard, second-hand, and not the best quality." A lot of times people only want to be the assistant or vice-president long enough to climb the ladder and step the stone for the "real job" of being on top and in control.

But is this how God sees it?

### A Testimony

I was in a shipping department several years ago and one of my co-workers was complaining that he did not know what his job title was. All of the employees were packing boxes. The supervisor listened to the guy go on and on. Finally the supervisor said, "You are a *Do What*. You do what I say when I say it!" That is what an Associate is in a nutshell- a Do What.

### Lifestyle Servants

Paul had a servant's mentality. He shared his "whatever it takes" attitude this way: "To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all *men*, that I might by all means save some. And this I do for the gospel's sake." *1 Corinthians* 9:22-23

The servants Paul depended on all shared this view. At the end of each of his letters, he would commend and appreciate these servants. (*See Romans 16 and 1 Corinthians 16*).

Paul went on to elaborate his view of a servant. He called it "The mind (attitude, deamor) of Christ. See Philippians 2.

#### Who Gets To See the Miracle?

In the Marriage at Canna, when Jesus performed his first public miracle, only the servants- the officials- knew the source of how the water turned to wine. (*See John 2:1-11*).

In the story of Matthew 8:5-13 it was the Centurion that received a miracle of a healed servant because he understood how the chain of command worked. This amazed Jesus!

#### The True Power Wielder

In Exodus, who had the most power- Pharaoh or Meek Moses?

Was Joshua, the name sake of the Book of Joshua, always the great General of the Faith? He is recorded to be Moses minister in Exodus 24:13.

Elisha did amazing miracles, but his start was as Elijah's minister in 1 Kings 19:19-21.

"Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth." Matthew 5:5

## The Apron & Towel

In the Upper Room during the Last Supper, the chief servant was in action (*See John 13*). Jesus' example is powerful. He also gave guidance.

"If I then, *your* Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you. Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him. If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them." *John 13:14-17*
